

MCFD Applicant Information Checklist

- 1 Membership within the Department will require an extra 10-15 hours per week of your time for participation.
- 2 Members are required to maintain a minimum of 25% of monthly calls.
- 3 Members are required to attend weekly training, Thursday, day and night times are available. An Officer must be notified if you cannot attend.
- 4 When applying, there will be various checks done including: background, criminal history, Secretary of State driving history.
- 5 Prior to starting, you will be required to pass a physical exam and a drug test.
- 6 While on probation, there will be an extra training and classes in addition to above requirements, to meet State of Michigan mandates. The MCFD will pay for these classes. Hours for Firefighter I are about 145 hours. Hours for Michigan First Responders are about 100 hours.
